

Pharmacist Prescriptive Authority and Reimbursement for Extended Counseling Sessions

Beginning June 13th, 2022, Pharmacists with prescriptive authority, who provide extended counseling to patients, will be able to submit for reimbursement in 15-minute intervals. Reimbursement will also include the cost of the drug, the dispensing fee, and a clinical service payment for prescribing the drug. Documentation of clinical encounters will be required.

This will apply to the following drug classes: *

- Hormonal contraception
- Tobacco Cessation
- Immunization
- Naloxone
- HIV PEP Therapy
- TB testing

Counseling Services should be submitted with DUR codes: Reason PP, Professional, PE Result 1B.

REASON	PROFESSIONAL	RESULT	LEVEL OF EFFORT	TIME (minutes)
PP	PE	1B	11	0-15
PP	PE	1B	12	16-30
PP	PE	1B	13	31-45
PP	PE	1B	14	46-60

- Level of Effort 11 = 0-15 minutes counseling
- Level of Effort 12 = 16-30 minutes counseling
- Level of Effort 13 = 31-45 minutes counseling
- Level of Effort 14 = 46-60 minutes counseling

By submitting the LOE you are attesting that counseling has been provided for the length of time submitted on the claim.
